
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



Voyage Operations and Monitoring



Guidance and oversight by the Global Marine team to manage the end-to-end voyage.

Operations


- Leverage in-house resources, such as Polar Tankers, for situational advice or additional oversight
- Consider voyage specifics and operations
 - Passage plan review
 - · Terminal operations
- Review and advise as needed with relevant guidance
 - · Provide manuals and highlight required information
 - · Reinforce pertinent details with vessel operator
 - Vessel attendance during port call as needed by Polar Superintendent

Coordination & Monitoring

- Managed by Global Marine's Commercial Marine team in collaboration with Polar Tankers
- Daily communications and updates from the vessel
- Provide charterer's instructions / voyage orders
- Monitor changes in vessel condition or status
