6:30-7:00pm **Scott Pegau**, the Research Program Manager for the **Oil Spill Recovery Institute (OSRI)** in Cordova, will present his work on the 2009 field experiment that OSRI and **Alaska Ocean Observing System** conducted to test the ocean observing system and models in Prince William Sound.

7:00-7:45pm **Stanley "Jeep" Rice**, with the **National Oceanic & Atmospheric Administration** will speak on **The Exxon Valdez Oil Spill: Long Term Persistence and Long Term Effects**.
